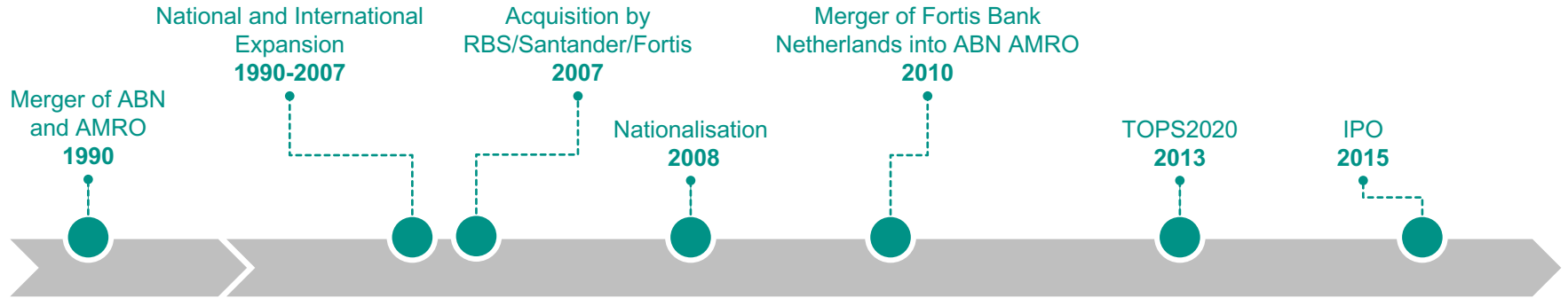

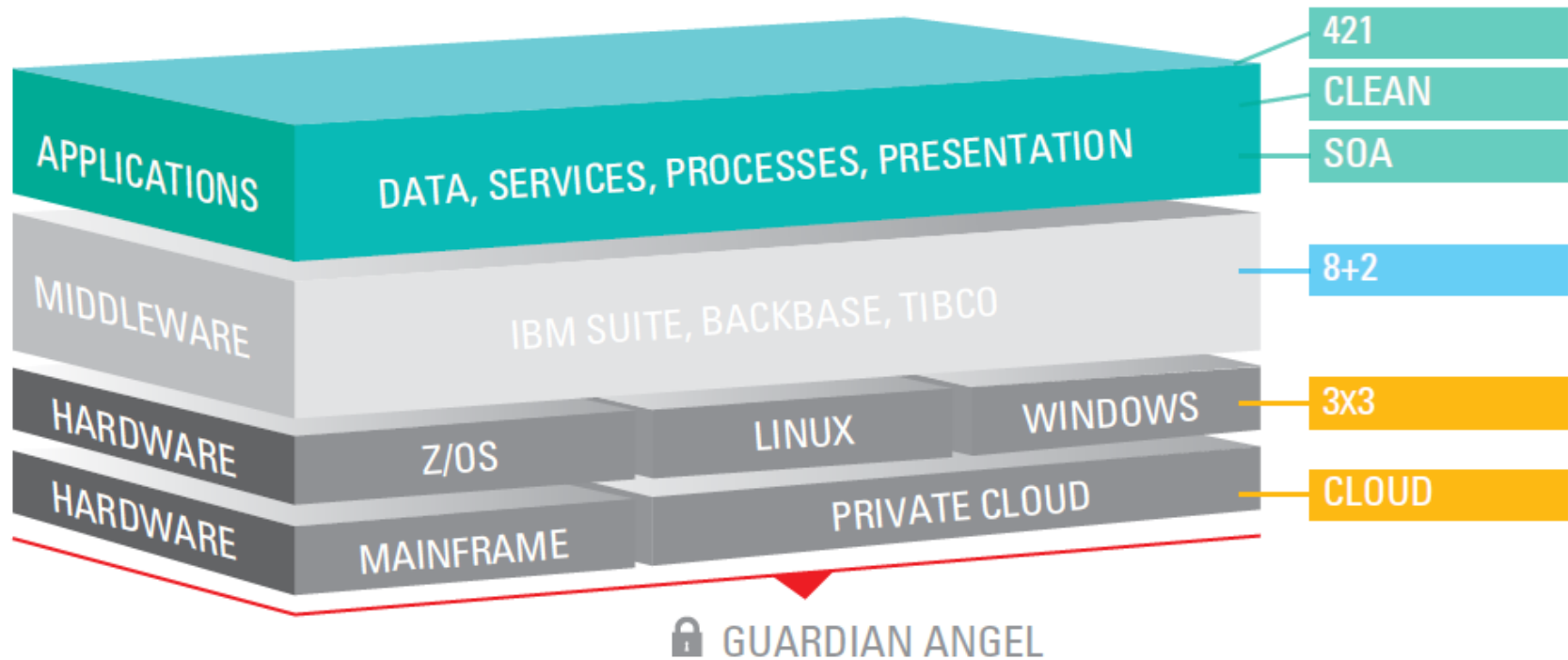

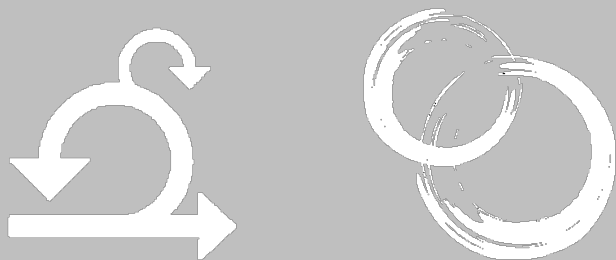

Strategy and challenges

- ▶ Transformation to Private Cloud still ongoing
- ▶ No large scale migration to Public Cloud
- ▶ Scorecard for deciding between Private and Public
- ▶ AWS versus Azure driven by preference and skills
- ▶ New collaboration methods: DevOps versus traditional



IT Brokerage

Develop a function to determine which workload lands on which platform
